of India visited IQAC M.M Mahila College Ara on 15.3.2023 at 11:30 a.m. They enquired about

institutional sustainability, experiential learning, rural entrepreneurship, green environment,

energy conservation, skill development programmes for students as well as for faculty

members and waste management. IQAC coordinator provided information and answered the

questions as per best of her knowledge. After knowing the current status on all required points,

the faculty members from MGNCRE suggested some very innovative ideas within the financial

and infrastructure limits of the institution for promoting sustainability and green environment.

They suggested:

1. Campus bazaar (students selling their own hand made products like paintings, cloths,

2. Green campus maintenance with the help of students itself. (training for gardening and
